FINAL ORDER

This matter coming to be heard this 20th day of September, 2022, as an assessment of a civil penalty under Article 9 of the Illinois Election Code (10 ILCS 5/9-1 *et seq.*), and the State Board of Elections being fully advised in the premises,

THE BOARD FINDS:

1. On July 22, 2022, in case number 22DQ072, a \$1,125.00 civil penalty was assessed against Respondent for the delinquent filing of the December 2021 Quarterly Report, and Respondent was notified thereof by letter on the same date; and
2. An appeal of the civil penalty was not submitted by the Committee; and
3. Previously civil penalties were assessed against Respondent for delinquent filings. These assessments were not appealed and remain unpaid.
